Foreign trade data has been prepared according to TURKSTAT Special Trade System. In the General Trade System (GTS), goods entering and leaving the Customs areas and free zones are also included in the foreign trade data. In the Special Trade System (STS), the customs border is taken as a basis. According to this definition, free zones and customs warehouses are located outside the customs border.

We left behind the first half of 2022 with the ongoing fragility in the supply chain, Russia-Ukraine tension and recession concerns.

It is seen that the food crisis concerns that came to the agenda with the war between Russia and Ukraine, one of the world's largest grain exporters, and the increase in grain prices decreased with the Grain Corridor Agreement, which was signed under the leadership of our country in the past days, which will enable the grain of Russia and Ukraine to be offered to the world markets via the Black Sea.

This agreement made under the leadership of our country will have a very positive psychological contribution and will wreak havoc on speculators.

In addition to this positive development from outside, another pleasing development is that the harvest is almost complete in our country and there will be no problem in terms of harvest.

In addition, we consider the TGB purchase prices announced by our Honorable President as another positive development, and we hope that it will have a very positive impact on the sustainability of our country's wheat production.

As you can see from our report in which we presented the January-June data, it is seen that the success of our sector in exports continues, and it has succeeded in increasing our exports in terms of both quantity and value compared to the same period last year.

However, as we always say, although the increase in our export price seems high, it is seen that the increase in raw material prices is much higher despite the use of bread wheat in exports to Africa and South America.





EXPORT UNIT PRICE COMPARISON (\$)





When the pasta export is examined by years, it is seen that the export has increased continuously except 2015. However, as of 2014, with the gradual decrease in the unit export price, although more exports were made, no income was obtained there. While the lowest average unit export price was realized with 458 dollars / ton in 2018, the unit export price increased with the increase in wheat costs after this year and was realized at the level of \$700/ton as of June 2022.





DURUM WHEAT IMPORT PER YEAR



When the durum wheat import is examined in the 10-year period covering the years 2012-2022, it is seen that the years 2019 and 2020 stand out in terms of both quantity and average unit import price. Although the import unit price, which was around 400 dollars / ton in 2012-2015, decreased rapidly after 2015, it followed an increasing trend after 2018 and was realized at the level of \$592/ton as of June 2022.






UNIT PRICE COMPARISON OF DURUM WHEAT IMPORT AND PASTA EXPORT (\$/TON)



JANUARY - JUNE TOTAL QUANTITY COMPARISON (1000TON)






JANUARY - JUNE TOTAL VALUE COMPARISON (MILLION\$)

In June 2022 compared to June 2021, Pasta Exports increased 6.64% and reached to 120.28 thousand tons, in quantity; increased 44.03% and reached to \$92.51 million in value.


Between January - June 2022, compared to same period of the previous year, pasta exports increased 3.62% and reached to 665.47 thousand tons, in quantity; increased 32.12% and reached to \$466.09 million in value.

Average unit price per ton was \$569 in June 2021. It increased 35.06% and reached to \$769 in June 2022.

Compared to same period of the previous year, between January and June 2022, average price per ton increased 27.50% and reached to \$700/ton.



PASTA EXPORT BY COUNTRY JANUARY - JUNE 2022




Between January and June 2022, biggest exports was made to Somali with 83 thousand tons, followed by Venezuela and Ghana. In terms of value, biggest importer is Somali with \$50 million, followed by Venezuela and Ukraine, respectively.

On the basis of unit price amongst top 10 countries we export to in 2022, Japan ranked first with \$887/ton. Benin was on the last place with \$579/ton.

In May 2022, biggest exports, in terms of quantity was made to Ukraine with 16 thousand tons, followed by Iraq and Benin.

In May 2022, among the top 10 countries we export to on the basis of unit price, Syria ranked 1st with \$971/ton, followed by Japan (\$923/ton) and Ukraine (\$859/ton) respectively. Iraq had the lowest price with \$586/ton.

When the pasta export is analyzed by years, it is seen that the increasing trend continues. In 2021, it reached its highest level with \$ 776 million.

It is seen that the unit export price reached its highest level so far with <u>769 dollars/ton</u> obtained in June 2022.




PASTA EXPORT QUANTITY (KG)


MONTHLY EXPORT QUANTITY (KG)

When the pasta export is analyzed on a monthly basis, it is seen that the increasing trend continues here as well, but it is seen that the export amount has decreased in recent months compared to previous years. The highest monthly value achieved so far was 135.82 thousand tons in March 2022, while the export of 86 thousand tons in January 2021 was the lowest monthly value achieved in recent years.



According to Trademap data, in 2021, Turkey ranked in 2nd place after Italy in 1902.19 GTIP pasta exports, with 27,5% (2020-%27,7) market share. But, it took the last place among the countries exporting over 20 thousand tons with an export value of \$559/ton.

According to Trademap data, in 2021, USA ranked first with 9.2% share in 1902.19 GTIP pasta imports. Germany (345K tons) and France (303K tons) followed USA, respectively. Venezuela, which Turkey exported 212K tons of pasta in 2021, is the fourth largest importer country.

In June 2022 compared to June 2021, durum wheat imports decreased -2.84% and fell to 11.28 thousand tons, in quantity; increased 62.18% and reached to \$6.91 million in value.


Between January - June 2022, compared to same period of the previous year, durum wheat imports decreased -75.72% and fell to 63.16 thousand tons, in quantity; decreased -59.49% and fell to \$37.37 million in value.

Average unit price per ton was \$367 in June 2021. It increased 66.92% and reached to \$613 in June 2022.

Compared to same period of the previous year, between January and June 2022, average price per ton increased 66.87% and reached to \$592/ton.



DURUM WHEAT IMPORT BY COUNTRY JANUARY - JUNE 2022




Between January and June 2022, biggest importer of durum wheat was Greece with 31 thousand tons (\$19 million), followed by Mexico and Syria.

Average unit price of durum wheat imported by Greece was \$617/ton. Lowest price belonged to Lebanon with \$240/ton, while the highest unit price belongs to United States with \$114000/ton.



DURUM WHEAT IMPORT BY COUNTRY **MAY 2022**




In May 2022, where durum wheat was imported was the bigest country Mexico. Mexico imported 9 thousand tons of durum wheat (\$5 million), with \$620/ton average unit price.

DURUM WHEAT IMPORT VALUE (USD)


MONTHLY IMPORT VALUE (USD)

MONTHLY IMPORT UNIT PRICE (USD/TON)




When the monthly import values of durum wheat are analyzed, it is seen that the increasing trend continues. The highest value obtained in imports of durum wheat, in which the years 2019 and 2020 stand out, was realized in January 2020 with 102 million dollars.

When analyzed on unit price basis, it is seen that the price of 622 dollars / ton realized in May 2022 is the highest value achieved until this time. It was realized with a price of 613 dollars/ton in June 2022.




DURUM WHEAT IMPORT QUANTITY (KG)


MONTHLY IMPORT QUANTITY (KG)






DURUM WHEAT PRODUCTION PER YEAR




DURUM WHEAT YIELD PER YEAR (KG/DECARE)



DURUM WHEAT HARVEST AREA PER YER (DECARE)



















