The source of the data contained in the report is; Turkey Statistical Institute (TUIK) and Trademap. You can reach the PASTA SECTOR STATISTICS Panel prepared by Agrimetre for MÜSAD on the web page www.musad.org.tr.

Foreign trade data has been prepared according to TURKSTAT Special Trade System. In the General Trade System (GTS), goods entering and leaving the Customs areas and free zones are also included in the foreign trade data. In the Special Trade System (STS), the customs border is taken as a basis. According to this definition, free zones and customs warehouses are located outside the customs border.



### Hello,

We are currently in a period where the suspension of the Grain Corridor agreement and the ongoing drought worldwide significantly increase the risks in wheat supply. While these global challenges persist, our country is approaching the end of the wheat harvest season. Despite high expectations for a bountiful harvest, it is now evident that the above-average rainfall since April will not meet these high expectations. The Turkish Grain Board (TMO) is entering the season with its highest stockpile in history.

Amidst ongoing global supply risks and the expected level of harvest, discussions are taking place regarding allowing wheat exports. Allowing our wheat to be exported without being processed will not only weaken the competitiveness of our industries in the international market but will also hinder the opportunity to export value-added products by processing our own crops. Additionally, exporting quality products may lead to quality issues in domestic consumption.

For such a decision, it is crucial to wait until the end of the harvest season and assess the actual yield. If the harvest indeed proves to be abundant and the product of high quality, we will support any decision that benefits our country. However, making such a decision without observing the actual harvest and quality may have short-term positive effects but could result in negative consequences for our country in the medium and long term.

Global conditions and our current economic circumstances necessitate careful and accurate decision-making; unfortunately, we do not have the luxury of making mistakes.






### EXPORT VALUE COMPARISON (MILLION\$)





When pasta exports are analyzed by years, it is seen that although the export decreased after the peak of 2020 on quantity basis, it has increased continuously since 2015 on value basis.

It is seen that the average export price has reached the highest level in 2022 with the negative developments in the raw material and supply chain. While the lowest average unit export price was realized with 458 dollars/ton in 2018, the unit export price also increased with the increase in wheat costs after this year and realized as \$701/ton as of June 2023.











When durum wheat imports are examined in the 10-year period covering the years 2012-2022, it is seen that 2019 and 2020 stand out in terms of imported amount. The import unit price, which was around 400 dollars/ton in 2012-2015, decreased rapidly after 2015, but increased rapidly after 2020 and was realized at the level of \$419/ton as of June 2023.



## 2023 - 2022 DURUM WHEAT IMPORT AND PASTA EXPORT








### JANUARY - JUNE TOTAL VALUE COMPARISON (MILLION\$)

In June 2023 compared to June 2022, Pasta Exports decreased -1.17% and fell to 117.44 thousand tons, in quantity; decreased -12.90% and fell to \$79.94 million in value.


Between January - June 2023, compared to same period of the previous year, pasta exports decreased -2.61% and fell to 640.03 thousand tons, in quantity; decreased -2.75% and fell to \$448.46 million in value.

Average unit price per ton was \$772 in June 2022. It decreased -11.87% and fell to \$681 in June 2023.

Compared to same period of the previous year, between January and June 2023, average price per ton decreased -0.15% and fell to \$701/ton.



# PASTA EXPORT BY COUNTRY JANUARY - JUNE 2023




Between January and June 2023, biggest exports was made to Somali with 111 thousand tons, followed by Venezuela and Benin. In terms of value, biggest importer is Somali with \$71 million, followed by Venezuela and Japan, respectively.

On the basis of unit price amongst top 10 countries we export to in 2023, Japan ranked first with \$1068/ton. Venezuela was on the last place with \$544/ton.








In June 2023, biggest exports, in terms of quantity was made to Venezuela with 29 thousand tons, followed by Somali and Benin.

In June 2023, among the top 10 countries we export to on the basis of unit price, Japan ranked 1st with \$1035/ton, followed by Canada (\$817/ton) and Tanzania (\$638/ton) respectively. Iraq had the lowest price with \$529/ton.



## PASTA EXPORT VALUE BY YEARS (USD)


#### **MONTHLY EXPORT VALUE (USD)**


When the pasta export is analyzed by years, it is seen that the increasing trend continues. In 2022, it reached its highest level with \$ 962 million.

It is seen that the unit export price reached its highest level so far with <u>788 dollars/ton</u> obtained in July 2022.






### **MONTHLY EXPORT QUANTITY (KG)**

When pasta exports are analyzed on a monthly basis, it is seen that the export amount peaked in 2020 and decreased after this year.

When the last two years are examined, the highest monthly value achieved was 132,6 thousand tons in March 2022, while the export of 86,5 thousand tons in January 2021 was the lowest monthly value obtained in recent years.









According to Trademap data, Turkey ranked in 2nd place after Italy in 1902.19 GTIP pasta exports in 2021, with 25,7% (2020-%25,7) market share. But Iran and Turkey took the last places among the countries exporting over 20 thousand tons with an export value.

According to Trademap data, USA ranked first with 9.0% share in 1902.19 GTIP pasta imports in 2021. Germany (351K tons) and France (304K tons) followed respectively. Venezuela, which Turkey exported 212K tons of pasta in 2021, is the fifth largest importer country.







In June 2023 compared to June 2022, durum wheat imports increased 363.47% and reached to 52.27 thousand tons, in quantity; increased 183.56% and reached to \$19.61 million in value.


Between January - June 2023, compared to same period of the previous year, durum wheat imports increased 306.59% and reached to 256.8 thousand tons, in quantity; increased 187.69% and reached to \$107.52 million in value.

Average unit price per ton was \$613 in June 2022. It decreased -38.82% and fell to \$375 in June 2023.

Compared to same period of the previous year, between January and June 2023, average price per ton decreased -29.24% and fell to \$419/ton.



# DURUM WHEAT IMPORT BY COUNTRY JANUARY - JUNE 2023




Between January and June 2023, biggest importer of durum wheat was Kazakhstan with 102 thousand tons (\$40 million), followed by Russia and Canada.

Average unit price of durum wheat imported by Kazakhstan was \$393/ton. Lowest price belonged to Greece with \$361/ton, while the highest unit price belongs to Uzbekistan with \$83000/ton.

In June 2023, where durum wheat was imported was the bigest country Kazakhstan. Kazakhstan imported 41 thousand tons of durum wheat (\$16 million), with \$382/ton average unit price.





#### **YEARLY IMPORT VALUE (USD)**








When monthly import values of durum wheat are analyzed, it is seen that the increasing trend continues. The highest value obtained in the import of durum wheat, in which 2019 and 2020 stood out, was realized in January 2020 with 102 million dollars. When analyzed on a unit price basis, it is seen that the price of 622 dollars/ton realized in May 2022 is the highest value obtained so far. Import price realized as \$375.1/ton as of June 2023.




## **DURUM WHEAT IMPORT QUANTITY (KG)**






#### **DURUM WHEAT PRODUCTION PER YEAR**




### **DURUM WHEAT YIELD PER YEAR (KG/DECARE)**



### **DURUM WHEAT HARVEST AREA PER YER (DECARE)**




#### **RATIO OF DURUM WHEAT HARVEST AREA**















