Foreign trade data has been prepared according to TURKSTAT Special Trade System. In the General Trade System (GTS), goods entering and leaving the Customs areas and free zones are also included in the foreign trade data. In the Special Trade System (STS), the customs border is taken as a basis. According to this definition, free zones and customs warehouses are located outside the customs border.

When pasta exports are analyzed by years, it is seen that although the export decreased after the peak of 2020 on quantity basis, it has increased continuously since 2015 on value basis.

It is seen that the average export price has reached the highest level in 2022 with the negative developments in the raw material and supply chain. While the lowest average unit export price was realized with 458 dollars/ton in 2018, the unit export price also increased with the increase in wheat costs after this year and realized as \$675/ton as of November 2023.

When durum wheat imports are examined in the 10-year period covering the years 2012-2022, it is seen that 2019 and 2020 stand out in terms of imported amount. The import unit price, which was around 400 dollars/ton in 2012-2015, decreased rapidly after 2015, but increased rapidly after 2020 and was realized at the level of \$416/ton as of November 2023.

PASTA EXPORT

In November 2023 compared to November 2022, Pasta Exports increased 13.86% and reached to 124.81 thousand tons, in quantity; decreased -0.34% and fell to \$81.33 million in value.

Between January - November 2023, compared to same period of the previous year, pasta exports increased 0.83% and reached to 1.23 million tons, in quantity; decreased -5.21% and fell to \$830.94 million in value.

Average unit price per ton was \$744 in November 2022. It decreased -12.47% and fell to \$652 in November 2023.

Compared to same period of the previous year, between January and November 2023, average price per ton decreased -5.98% and fell to \$675/ton.





Between January and November 2023, biggest exports was made to Somali with 209 thousand tons, followed by Venezuela and Togo. In terms of value, biggest importer is Somali with \$132 million, followed by Venezuela and Japan, respectively.

On the basis of unit price amongst top 10 countries we export to in 2023, Japan ranked first with \$1009/ton. Iraq was on the last place with \$516/ton.

In November 2023, biggest exports, in terms of quantity was made to Venezuela with 19 thousand tons, followed by Somali and Togo.

In November 2023, among the top 10 countries we export to on the basis of unit price, China ranked 1st with \$926/ton, followed by Japan (\$898/ton) and Israel (\$786/ton) respectively. Iraq had the lowest price with \$487/ton.

When the pasta export is analyzed by years, it is seen that the increasing trend continues. In 2022, it reached its highest level with \$ 962 million.

It is seen that the unit export price reached its highest level so far with 788 dollars/ton obtained in July 2022.

When pasta exports are analyzed on a monthly basis, it is seen that the export amount peaked in 2020 and decreased after this year.

When the last two years are examined, the highest monthly value achieved was **132,6 thousand tons** in March 2022, while the export of **68,2 thousand tons** in February 2023 was the lowest monthly value obtained in recent years.

In November 2023 compared to November 2022, durum wheat imports decreased -81.51% and fell to 5.66 thousand tons, in quantity; decreased -82.70% and fell to \$2.4 million in value.

Between January - November 2023, compared to same period of the previous year, durum wheat imports increased 65.98% and reached to 286.56 thousand tons, in quantity; increased 25.10% and reached to \$119.23 million in value.

Average unit price per ton was \$453 in November 2022. It decreased -6.46% and fell to \$424 in November 2023.

Compared to same period of the previous year, between January and November 2023, average price per ton decreased -24.63% and fell to \$416/ton.





Between January and November 2023, biggest importer of durum wheat was Kazakhstan with 105 thousand tons (\$41 million), followed by Russia and Canada.

Average unit price of durum wheat imported by Kazakhstan was \$392/ton. Lowest price belonged to Greece with \$361/ton, while the highest unit price belongs to Uzbekistan with \$83000/ton.

In November 2023, where durum wheat was imported was the bigest country Syria. Syria imported 5 thousand tons of durum wheat (\$2 million), with \$432/ton average unit price.

In November 2023, countries that imported durum wheat were Syria, Kazakhstan, Canada, respectively.

When monthly import values of durum wheat are analyzed, it is seen that the increasing trend continues. The highest value obtained in the import of durum wheat, in which 2019 and 2020 stood out, was realized in January 2020 with 102 million dollars. When analyzed on a unit price basis, it is seen that the price of 622 dollars/ton realized in May 2022 is the highest value obtained so far. Import price realized as \$424.1/ton as of November 2023.
