In the General Trade System (GTS), goods entering and leaving the Customs areas and free zones are also included in the foreign trade data. In the Special Trade System (STS), the customs border is taken as a basis. According to this definition, free zones and customs warehouses are located outside the customs border.












EXPORT VALUE COMPARISON (MILLION\$)





When pasta exports are analyzed by years, it is seen that although the export decreased after the peak of 2020 on quantity basis, it has increased continuously since 2015 on value basis.

It is seen that the average export price has reached the highest level in 2022 with the negative developments in the raw material and supply chain. While the lowest average unit export price was realized with 458 dollars/ton in 2018, the unit export price also increased with the increase in wheat costs after this year and realized as \$673/ton as of December 2023.





When durum wheat imports are examined in the 10-year period covering the years 2012-2022, it is seen that 2019 and 2020 stand out in terms of imported amount. The import unit price, which was around 400 dollars/ton in 2012-2015, decreased rapidly after 2015, but increased rapidly after 2020 and was realized at the level of \$416/ton as of December 2023.




DURUM WHEAT EXPORT QUANTITY SEASONAL COMPARISON (1000TON)



2023/24 SEASON DURUM WHEAT EXPORTS PER COUNTRY



JANUARY - DECEMBER TOTAL VALUE COMPARISON (MILLION\$)




JANUARY - DECEMBER AVERAGE UNIT PRICE COMPARISON (\$/TON)

In December 2023 compared to December 2022, Pasta Exports decreased -0.95% and fell to 114.1 thousand tons, in quantity; decreased -13.20% and fell to \$74.58 million in value.


Between January - December 2023, compared to same period of the previous year, pasta exports increased 0.67% and reached to 1.35 million tons, in quantity; decreased -5.92% and fell to \$905.5 million in value.

Average unit price per ton was \$746 in December 2022. It decreased -12.36% and fell to \$654 in December 2023.

Compared to same period of the previous year, between January and December 2023, average price per ton decreased -6.55% and fell to \$673/ton.








In 2023, biggest exports was made to Somali with 224 thousand tons, followed by Venezuela and Togo. In terms of value, biggest importer is Somali with \$142 million, followed by Venezuela and Japan, respectively.

On the basis of unit price amongst top 10 countries we export to in 2023, Japan ranked first with \$1003/ton. Iraq was on the last place with \$514/ton.



PASTA EXPORT BY COUNTRY DECEMBER 2023




In December 2023, biggest exports, in terms of quantity was made to Venezuela with 18 thousand tons, followed by Somali and Ghana.

In December 2023, among the top 10 countries we export to on the basis of unit price, United States ranked 1st with \$1166/ton, followed by Japan (\$913/ton) and Somali (\$634/ton) respectively. Iraq had the lowest price with \$492/ton.



PASTA EXPORT VALUE BY YEARS (USD)


MONTHLY EXPORT VALUE (USD)

MONTHLY EXPORT UNIT PRICE (USD/TON)




When the pasta export is analyzed by years, it is seen that the increasing trend continues. In 2022, it reached its highest level with \$ 962 million.

It is seen that the unit export price reached its highest level so far with <u>788 dollars/ton</u> obtained in July 2022.







MONTHLY EXPORT QUANTITY (KG)

When pasta exports are analyzed on a monthly basis, it is seen that the export amount peaked in 2020 and decreased after this year.

When the last two years are examined, the highest monthly value achieved was 132,6 thousand tons in March 2022, while the export of 68,2 thousand tons in February 2023 was the lowest monthly value obtained in recent years.





Export Quantity in 2023 on the Basis of Sub-Group (1000Ton)











According to Trademap data, USA ranked first with 11.2% share in 1902.19 GTIP pasta imports in 2021. Germany (380K tons) and France (324K tons) followed respectively.







In December 2023 compared to December 2022, durum wheat imports decreased -72.50% and fell to 5.32 thousand tons, in quantity; decreased -77.60% and fell to \$2.15 million in value.


Between January - December 2023, compared to same period of the previous year, durum wheat imports increased 52.02% and reached to 291.88 thousand tons, in quantity; increased 15.70% and reached to \$121.38 million in value.

Average unit price per ton was \$496 in December 2022. It decreased -18.52% and fell to \$404 in December 2023.

Compared to same period of the previous year, between January and December 2023, average price per ton decreased -23.89% and fell to \$416/ton.



DURUM WHEAT IMPORT BY COUNTRY JANUARY - DECEMBER 2023




In 2023, biggest importer of durum wheat was Kazakhstan with 107 thousand tons (\$42 million), followed by Russia and Canada.

Average unit price of durum wheat imported by Kazakhstan was \$392/ton. Lowest price belonged to Greece with \$361/ton, while the highest unit price belongs to Uzbekistan with \$83000/ton.



DURUM WHEAT IMPORT BY COUNTRY DECEMBER 2023





MONTHLY IMPORT UNIT PRICE (USD/TON)




When monthly import values of durum wheat are analyzed, it is seen that the increasing trend continues. The highest value obtained in the import of durum wheat, in which 2019 and 2020 stood out, was realized in January 2020 with 102 million dollars. When analyzed on a unit price basis, it is seen that the price of 622 dollars/ton realized in May 2022 is the highest value obtained so far. Import price realized as \$403.9/ton as of December 2023.






DURUM WHEAT PRODUCTION PER YEAR




DURUM WHEAT YIELD PER YEAR (KG/DECARE)



DURUM WHEAT HARVEST AREA PER YER (DECARE)




RATIO OF DURUM WHEAT HARVEST AREA











